Entry Central pass us the contact information for the team managers, we will use this to contact you regarding the Chase Walk in this year and to advise of the date and entry procedure for future years.

We will collect and process the following personal data about the members of your teams:

Main Walk:

Name - Required for identification

Age and Sex - Required to determine which class in the competition.

Telephone - Required in case we need to contact the team during the event.

Name, Age and Sex will be kept in the historical results and made available for the public on the Chase Walk website. We also publish your Team Name, Scout Group and District or Organisation.

Telephone data will be deleted after the event (within a maximum of 1 month)

Scouts Walk:

Name - Required for identification

Age and Sex - Required for event safety cover.

This data will be deleted after the event (within a maximum of 1 month)

Telephone numbers are requested and recorded on paper form only in case of requirement to contact teams during the event, these forms will be destroyed after the event.

We will not use your personal details for any marketing purpose.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website, it would not be able to function otherwise. Cookies are not shared with any other organisation.
